## Sports Day: Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2022

We are very excited to be able to host Sports Day this year following disruption over the past few years. We are even more excited to be welcoming families in to see their children during the events.

On Sports Day, we would like to invite children to wear their house colour t-shirt if possible. However, if they do not have a coloured top, they can still wear their white top. They should wear full PE kit on the day. Children should make sure they bring plenty of water to school. They should also bring sun hats and, where appropriate, sun cream. Staff will not be able to help children apply sun cream.

During all events, children must stay with their class adults and parents/carers need keep in designated areas. Younger siblings are politely requested to stay off the equipment set up for other year groups. Parents/carers may rotate round the activities in order to watch their child/children.

Gates will be locked at 9am as usual for registration.

9.15am- 10.15am - Key stage 1 and Reception potted sports (all children from year EYFS - Year 2). Children will participate in fun team activities.  
We will reopen the main school entrance gates (Egremont Road) at 9.10am for parents/carers to make their way to the events. The gates will be locked again at 9.25am.

At 10.15am, the gates will be reopened for you to leave the site. If you have a child in Key Stage 2, you may stay on the field where a member of our senior leadership team will be.

10.30am - 11.30am - Key Stage 2 potted sports (all children from Year 3 - 6). Children will participate in fun team activities.  
At 11.30am, parents/carers are politely asked to leave the school site, by 11.45am for the school lunch break.

1.20pm the Egremont Road gates will be reopened to allow parents/carers access to the school field.

1.30pm - 2:30pm - Races. All children will participate in a race. Parents/carers are requested to remain behind the taped off area.

2.30pm - 2.45pm - While the scores are being collated there will be parent/carers races and a preschool race.

2.45pm- Scores and winning house announced.



Children will return to their classrooms and parents/carers will be directed to wait where they would normally pick up their children. Children in Year 5 and 6 who usually walk home alone will be able to do so as usual at 3:15pm.

Please be aware, we are unable to allow parents/carers and siblings access to the school buildings to use the toilets.
