Dear Parents and Carers.

This year for our school trip, we have organised a day at Bedgebury Pinetum for the children to take part in a study of woodlands on Monday 29th April 2024. We will be participating in the 'From Tiny Seeds to Mighty Trees' workshop where the children will learn about how trees grow, the different types of trees at the pinetum and they will get the opportunity to plant seeds to bring back to the school. This links with last term's science topic of plants and term 1's topic of woodlands. The cost of the trip is £24 per child.

There will be a lunch break in the middle of the day. All children will need packed lunches. If your child is entitled to free school meals, please let myself or their class teacher know that they require a packed lunch made by the school. Please ensure that your child brings a water bottle with them.

Due to the weather being unpredictable, the children need to wear a pair of waterproof trainers that you do not mind getting a bit muddy. If it is hot, we recommend that the children bring hats and sun cream to help protect them from the sun but they cannot share these with other children. All children need to wear their school uniform.

Please ensure that your child is in school by 8.40am at the latest. The children will be brought back to school for dismissal at 3.15pm. If we are running behind schedule, the trip leader will contact the school so parents and carers can be updated.
