Dear Parents/Carers

As we approach the end of the academic year, it is an ideal opportunity to look back on what has happened but also our thoughts are turning to September and all that the new academic year will hold. Please ensure that you have returned your pink forms indicating who is allowed to pick up your child from school before the end of term to avoid any delays on that first day back—these must be completed with your child's NEW class details on. If you are not sure of your child's new class teacher, please read on as the list has been repeated later in this newsletter.

If your child has any medication in school, including asthma pumps or epi-pens, allergy medicine or painkillers, please collect these from the school office on the last day of term. If you need to return these to school in September, please ensure that you check the date and renew these over the summer if needs be. Please ensure that medication has the child's name and class clearly labelled and remember that any asthma pumps need to go to the child's new classroom on the first day of term. If your child does need medication in school, please do not send this in with your child but bring it to the school office where you will need to complete a form. Remember, medication cannot be sent home with a child and must be collected by an adult at the end of the day.


